

## **“TIN STAR” MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

### **Question:**

If I'm not in the emergency profession, is there a way can qualify to become a Tin Star?

### **Answer:**

Yes, here are the *minimum* certification requirements for the "Tin Star" badge.

The minimum requirements for those STAR members wanting to become a Tin Star but that do not fit within the above listed career list is to complete the following:

### **United States**

American Red Cross: **Emergency Response** course, code HSPRO103 (this is an approximately 50 hour course) this course exceeds the US DOT guidelines.

### **Canada**

Canadian Red Cross: **First Responder** course (this is an approximately 45 hour course)

**Contact your local Red Cross for information and certification.**

Once you have completed the course with a minimum score of 80 percent, forward a copy of your card and your completed Tin Star application to STAR Touring and Riding for approval and processing.
